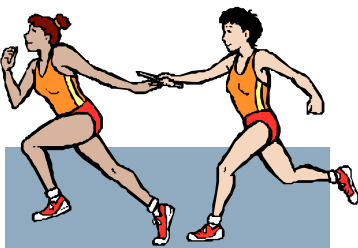
Also the senior girls relay team came 2nd on the day. It was great to see everyone active and participating in a friendly competitive environment.
